Welcome back! We are looking forward to a great year with Year 1 and would like to tell you about the weekly routine.

### A few reminders:

Our theme for the Autumn term is 'Our local area'. We will be learning about our what's in our local area, people that helps us in our community etc. Our aim this week is to settle the children into their new class and class routine.

- Please use the class DOJO for ANY notes, messages, and questions.
- Please place any money sent into school in a named envelope in their folder.
- Fruit shop is 40p a day, please ensure money is sent in at the beginning of the week or daily if using the shop.
- RWInc reading books will be sent home every Friday and returned to school on a **Wednesday**. The essential part of your child's progress is reading - if you can read with your child every day this will really help. I would be grateful if you could write on the reading record sheet when you have read together at home.
- P.E will be on a **Monday**. Please wear suitable kit to school on this day e.g. shorts, T-shirt, trainers. We will also be using the outdoors for P.E when possible. No jewellery should be worn on P.E days, including earrings.
- Please ensure all clothing is clearly labelled e.g jumpers, coats, cardigans, hats.
- Please bring a bottle of water to school (which can be refilled with cooled, filtered water.) We ask that the children only have water in their bottles please. Bottles will be sent home daily to be washed.
- Water and milk are available during the day, and everyone is encouraged to drink often.
- Could you continue to ensure that I am aware of any changes in address, telephone numbers or medical information as soon as possible.
- If your child is going home with someone else, please let us know prior to pick up. Without parental consent, we are unable to release your child to anyone else. If there is a change to the person picking up during the day, please phone the school as we don't always check dojo during the school day. At the end of the day, the children will be dismissed from the side gate by the car park at 2.50pm. It would really help if you could wait near this entrance when we dismiss your child.
